**My/Our Students: Example** Our students are highly motivated, hard-working students who are developing the organizational skills they need to succeed in AP classes as they balance their academics with extracurricular activities and the demands placed on them from outside of school. Students in the AP Program represent over 10% of a diverse student population that exceeds 3200 students and consists of students who speak more than 50 languages. Like most AP students, these students have excellent academic records and excel in the classroom. They do this in combination with working, supporting their families, playing sports, and participating in a number of extracurricular activities. Our AP program provides underprivileged, working-class, and immigrant students the opportunity to be competitive at the highest levels of academic achievement. Most urban high schools struggle to provide an education. Our high school is different, and our AP Program is one of a myriad of academically rigorous programs that separate us. Even though many of our students are the first in their families to attend college and speak English as their second language, they are prepared both academically and emotionally for their post-secondary endeavors when they leave our school.

**My/Our Project: Example** Imagine over 350 students come to school voluntarily in the summer the week before school starts to get organized, review reading strategies, and practice study skills for their upcoming courses. That is what our AP students will be doing this summer. Students will have class with their teachers and attend classes focused on building study skills and literacy. In these classes students will learn to use organizational tools, such as their binders, and put them to use before school even starts. Students who attend the summer program will start school prepared, ready to face the academic challenges that lie ahead. Their decision to select these rigorous AP courses is based upon their individual ability, interests, and motivation. We've set high expectations for our students and they are willing to take the challenge. Now, it is our job to ensure that we provide them with the instruction and academic tools they need to succeed.
